<p>STANDARD: 4.3.1; 4.3.9</p> <p>NFPA 1001, 2019 Edition</p> <p>Fire Ground Operations</p>	<p>Task: Use SCBA during emergency operations, given SCBA and other personal protective equipment, so that the SCBA is correctly donned and activated within 1 minute, the SCBA is correctly worn, controlled breathing techniques are used, emergency procedures are enacted if the SCBA fails, all low-air warnings are recognized, respiratory protection is not intentionally compromised, and hazardous areas are exited prior to air depletion.</p>	
<p>PERFORMANCE OUTCOME: The candidate shall demonstrate the ability to Don SCBA within 1-minute, control breathing, replace SCBA air cylinders, use SCBA to exit through restricted passages, initiate and complete emergency procedures in the event of SCBA failure or air depletion, and complete donning procedures.</p> <p>Safety: A safety violation is grounds for automatic failure. All proctors present shall review the safety violation.</p>
